- We will review all students' liability forms prior to arrival to ensure they have been properly completed.
- Participants are <u>strongly urged</u> to carry plenty of water with them during the program. All should wear clothing appropriate for expected weather and close-toed shoes.
- All participants will adhere to program leader instructions provided while onsite.
- Both parties (Mitchell Lake Audubon Center and School/Organization) agree to mutually investigate any misconduct that results in vandalism, theft, or breakage of Mitchell Lake property and/or equipment.
- Individuals allergic to insect bites/stings should bring any required antidotes or medications.
- Cost per participant (students) is \$6.50 cash, check, and credit cards are accepted. Payment is due on day of program unless otherwise arranged with Mitchell Lake Audubon Center Staff. Returned checks due to insufficient funds will incur a \$30 fee.
